- In view of the continuing Covid-19 pandemic, the Ministry of Corporate Affairs ("MCA") has vide its circular dated May 5, 2022, December 14, 2021, December 8, 2021, January 13, 2021 May 5, 2020, April 13, 2020 and April 08, 2020 (collectively referred to as "MCA Circulars") permitted the holding of the Annual General Meeting ("AGM") through VC / OAVM, without the physical presence of the Members at a common venue. The following Statement sets out all material facts relating to Special Business mentioned in the accompanying Notice:

ITEM-3

The members of the Company had approved the appointment of M/s Suresh Kumar Mittal & Co., Chartered Accountants, having registration number 500063N as the Statutory Auditors at the 31st Annual General Meeting of the Company held on 25th September, 2017 to hold office for a period of 5 years till the conclusion of 36th Annual General Meeting.

Pursuant to Section 139(2) of the Act, the Company can appoint an audit firm for a second term of five consecutive years. Accordingly, M/s Suresh Kumar Mittal & Co., Chartered Accountants, are proposed to be re-appointed as Statutory Auditors of the Company for a second term of five consecutive years commencing from the conclusion of this Annual General Meeting till the conclusion of 41st Annual General Meeting.

In accordance with the Act and on recommendation of the Audit Committee and in the best interest of the Company, the Board of Directors have considered and recommended the proposed re-appointment of M/s Suresh Kumar Mittal & Co. Chartered Accountants as Statutory Auditors of the Company for another term of five consecutive years from the conclusion of this Annual General Meeting.
